## Ramadan Charity Boxes

RGWE's employees took the initiative of a charity campaign by distributing Ramadan food boxes to the least fortunate families. The employees' donation for this social activity was doubled by the company's contribution.

The collected fund permitted the purchase of 223 boxes containing some essential nutrition goods. The boxes were distributed as below:

- To RGWE's Site subcontractors laborer's
- To the Bedouins in the RGWE Site area.
- To RGWE Cairo HQ building laborer's
- To needed families of Ras Ghareb city which have been identified by the Ras Ghareb charity offices and active social workers.

## Scholarships

In accordance to the scholarship sponsor agreement signed with the Ras Ghareb municipality education representative, RGWE will provide scholarships to 4 additional students. Together with the 4 current beneficiaries, totaling 8 students.

The 4 new students are currently being selected and will start to receive their scholarship from September 2019 onwards.

The scholarships are for students completing their studies at one of the 3 schools in Ras Ghareb and willing to pursue university studies. The students are selected based on their school results, their motivation and their family's social and economical situation.

## Bird Monitoring



RGWE site is located in a bird migration corridor. During spring 2019, a second bird monitoring campaign was undertaken at our site. This has been performed by Green Plus under the supervision of RCREEE. A total of 8,942 observations of 195,729 birds were collected in the field belonging to 29 species. Five threatened species (Egyptian Vulture, Steppe Eagle, Imperial Eagle, Spotted Eagle, and Sooty Falcon) were recorded. The majority of birds belonged to only few species (White Stork 47%, Steppe Buzzard 26.8%, and Honey Buzzard 10.2%).

As our wind turbines started to operate in July 2019, RGWE will now implement shutdowns when required to avoid bird collisions. Observers will be at site during every spring and autumn seasons in order to instruct those turbines shutdowns when birds are observed in the vicinity.
